

<u>Serger Savvy Class - Hideaway Hanger Safe by Sookie Sews</u>

Sookie Sews has done it again and created a project that is not only instructional but useful. The hanger looks like a top in your closet, only it is much more than that; it hides a secret compartment. Imagine traveling and having a safe place to hide money or passports. Use it at home and hide items you don't want to be found.

This pattern features several techniques that can be mastered using your serger. Specific skills include:

- zipper insertion with a piping foot
- lace insertion using blind hem foot
- flatlock
- serger pintucks
- 4 thread overlock for overall construction

Please Note: We have much experience with BERNINA sergers and can assist you as needed. While we welcome other brands in this class, we do not have as much experience with them, but we will do our best to assist you. Please know how to thread your machine and bring your manual for reference, if needed.

Materials Needed:

- Fabric A (shown in dark peach)
 - o Front Top 17" X 3"
 - o (2) Front Bottom Sides 4' X 10"
 - o Front Bottom Center 10" X 10"
 - o Back 17" X 12"
 - o (2) Hanger Loops 3"X19"
- Fabric B (shown as light peach)
 - o Front Top Lining 17"X 3"
 - Front Bottom Lining 17" X 10"

- o Front Back Lining 17" X 12"
- Inside Pocket Front 6"X 7"
- Inside Pocket Back 6"X9"
- Lace
 - o (2) Flat Insertion Lace 1" X 10" (flat on both sides)
 - Scalloped Edge Lace 1"X37" (flat on one side and scalloped on the other)
- Zippers
 - o Small Zipper 3mm zipper 10"
 - Large Zipper 4.5mm or 5mm by the yard zipper cut to 20"

Supplies Needed:

Thread

- o (3) Standard Serger threads
- o (1) 12 Wt. Thread
- o (1) Untwisted Textured Serger Thread i.e Wonderfil Softloc

Serger Feet

- Standard or Clear Foot
- Blindstitch Foot
- Large Piping Foot
