Pattern: Aunties Two Little Poppins Bag

In this pattern there are 2 sizes of bags. The sample I made for the store, which is done in gray and pink flowered fabric, is the larger of the two. I also cut the handles at 27 inches instead of 24 inches.

#### Fabric Requirements

Purchase fabrics and supplies according to the information on the back of the pattern.

#### **Notions/Hardware**

Purchase a By Annie's 24 inch Zipper with double zipper pulls. These work best with this bag. The shop can order the color you need.

The 5 feet length of 1/4 inch (outside diameter) plumber's tubing can be purchased at most hardware stores. Purchase the one that is polyethylene "milky" white, it is a stiffer tubing than the clear vinyl one. It is easier to thread through the handles. We will cut this in class also.

#### **Sewing Machine**

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class). Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

#### **Required Feet/Accessories/Needles**

Regular foot for straight stitches (1/4 inch foot)
Foot for zigzag stitches
Walking Foot
Ouarter inch foot

## **General Sewing Supplies**

Thread to match all fabrics
Wonder Clips
Straight Pins
Scissors
Seam ripper

Chalk or Fabric Marker (I found the Clover chalk marker works best, lots of marking to do for the quilting on this bag)

Rotary Cutter and Mat (some are available on-site)

Rulers

Iron and Pressing Mat optional (some are available on-site)

Parchment Paper or Teflon sheet, A MUST HAVE (we will be working with Bosal that is fusible on both sides)
Hand needles

#### Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes
Sack Lunch and Drink

### **Pre-Class Instructions**

Cut out pattern pieces (see page 1of pattern) and label.

Cut out Bosal's In-R-Foam Plus and fuse to fabrics as instructed on page 2 (be sure to use a Teflon sheet or parchment paper, Bosal's In-R-Foam Plus is fusible on both sides.)

Quilt pieces according to directions on page 2.

Happy Handles - This is a link on how to make handles an easier way. Feel free to make them ahead of class if you wish.

#### **Happy Handles for Poppins Bags**

- 1) Cut 2 handles 4 inches wide and length of handles according to the pattern instructions
- 2) Cut Peltex 1 3/4 inches wide and length of the handles.
- 3) Fold right sides together lengthwise. Stitch the length of the handles leaving a 2 to 3 inch opening in the middle for turning.
- 4) Rotate seam so it is in the center, open seam on the short ends then sew across the using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seam. (No need to flatten the whole seam, only across the ends.)
- 5) Next slide peltex into each handle all the way to each end.
- 6) Draw lines 2 ½ inches from each end.
  - 7) Fold handle in half length wise and stitch the length between the two lines using a 1/8 seam.
- 8) Test the tubing to make sure it slides into the handles
- 9) Now your handles are ready to be sewn to your bag.
