Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

This spacious organizer stores and carries tools and supplies in its many pockets. The bag features handles and an adjustable/detachable carrying strap along with two removable pocket pages with mesh or vinyl pockets in a variety of styles.

Main fabric (bag body, outer pockets, pages)	1½ yards
Lining fabric (bag lining, pages)	1½ yards
Coordinating fabric (handles, straps, bindings, front pocket border, page facings)	1⅞ yards
ByAnnie's Soft and Stable®* (bag stabilizer) SS1072/SS2072	1½ yards
Fusible interfacing* (interfacings for border and page facings) SUP179	½ yard
Mesh fabric* (interior bag pockets) SUP209	½ yard [◇]
Mesh fabric* and/or Vinyl* (pockets on pages) SUP209 or SUP151	½ yard to 1 yard [◇]
Handbag zippers* ZIPYD To make the bag and pocket pages as directed in the pattern, you will need 222" of zipper tape and 16 (or more) pulls to make: Exterior zippers on bag: 38" double-slide and 16" single-slide Interior zippers for pocket on bag: 16" single-slide Zippers for pockets on pages: two 16" single-slide, ten 12" zippers with one or more slides <i>For help making zippers, see our Zippers Are Easy! videos.</i>	Two packages of ByAnnie's Zippers by the Yard

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PRE CLASS INSTRUCTIONS

Call the store to pre-order 2 packages of 4 yard zipper tape By Annie in the color you want. Please do this as soon as you choose your fabrics. With shipping issues lately, please allow us adequate time to get them in the store and be available for you when you come to class.

The first day of class we will start making the bag portion of this pattern. You will need to have the bias binding prepared. The second day of class we will be working on the pocket pages.

Before Class Allow adequate time to do these steps, do not try to accomplish this the night before class.

If you need quilting done for this project, contact Ellen at the shop to schedule. She needs a small amount of extra fabric to quilt on the long arm, so check with her before purchasing fabric.

- 1) Cut and quilt all fabric pattern pieces, the instructions are on page 4.
Do not cut any vinyl or mesh; I will talk about these in class. The pieces will depend on how you choose to do the pockets on the “pages.” The “pages” are on page 3, look the “pages” over and get an idea how many pockets you want, the size of the pockets, and what you will be putting in them.
- 2) Cut the quilted fabric and seal the edges. I like to use a narrow zigzag stitch. Some customers use a serger. (Page 5)
- 3) Label all the pieces. Labels can be found on page 18.
- 4) Prepare bias binding. (Page 5)
- 5) Prepare the straps and handles; instructions are on pages 10, 11, & 12. These include the carrying strap, carrying strap tabs, handles, and page strap.
- 6) I will talk about cutting the zippers in class; again you will determine how many pockets will be zippered. There are 17 zippers in my bag. All the cut ends of the zippers will need to be stitched across OR I used Bonic to seal the ends. This product is a glue and hardens with an UV light in 4 seconds. It can also be used to mend all kinds of plastics, etc. This can be ordered from Amazon, Walmart etc. Again this is optional but saved me a lot of stitching time!
