Fabric Requirements

Fabric enough to complete the project – Read the back of the pattern you purchase for fabric suggestions and yardage requirements. Woven fabrics only, no Knits please.

Notions/Embellishments/Notions

- Pattern Tracing Paper – I LOVE Tracing Vellum. Or paper that is transparent so you can see thru to trace out a pattern. Need one roll.
- Matching thread and wound bobbin (cotton or cotton blend)
- Sewing needles – 80/12
- Seam gauge
- Tape measure
- Fabric chalk or removeable marking pen
- Pencil/marker
- Scissors
- Seam ripper
- Straight pins
- French Curve Ruler
- See through ruler – I recommend 2” wide or close
- **Read back of pattern for any notions specific to your pattern (double folding bias tape/buttons/elastic for waist/fusible interfacing etc.)**

Sewing Machine

This will be a hands-on class and a sewing machine is required. Participants MUST understand how to sew and be familiar with sewing machine operation.

80/12 sewing needles

Read back of pattern, recommend bringing 1 yard of fusible interfacing.
