### **Fabric and Notions Requirements**

Purchase fabrics according to the back of the pattern

In addition, you will need to purchase extra fabric for fussy cutting and adding the extra pocket to the back of the bag.

Soft N Stable

1 - 30 inch double slide handbag zippers

1 inch slider (HAR1-SL)

2 D-rings

1 inch wide polypro strapping – 2 yards

Decor bond one piece 9 inches by 12 inches if adding the back pocket

By Annie products are available at the shop.

### **Sewing Machine**

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

### **Required Feet/Accessories/Needles**

Regular foot for straight stitches (1/4 inch foot)

Foot for zigzag stitches

Optional: Edge foot (#10, #10C, #10D)

Universal needles 90/14

### **General Sewing Supplies**

Sewing thread to match all fabrics

Wonder Clips

Straight Pins

Scissors

Seam ripper

Fabric marker

Rotary Cutter and Mat

Rulers

Iron and Pressing Mat optional (some are available on-site)

Stiletto

12 mm bias tape maker (if making the fabric zipper pulls)

Large safety pin, bodkin, or turning tool to turn strap

### **Misc. Items**

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes

Sack Lunch and Drink

## **Pre-Class Instructions**

**Before Class** (Allow adequate time to do these steps, do not try to accomplish this the night before class)

- 1) Cut the main fabric, Soft and Stable, and lining fabric according to the instructions on page 1. Please note that if you want to fussy cut the fabric to “focus” on the front of the bag, and not sure of how to do this, bring your fabric to class. We can do this in class. Additionally, if you want to add a back pocket, the cutting can be done in class. Extra inside pockets can be added if desired. Bring your extra fabrics.
- 2) Label all the pieces. Labels can be found on page 5. Make a copy of the labels and save the original. You will want to make more than one.
- 3) Prepare the carrying strap and strap tabs on Page 2.
