Fabric Requirements:

Exterior fabric (quilting cotton, denim, linen, lightweight canvas or pro light cork)

1/3 yard, if the fabric is 27 inches wide (pro cork)

3/8 yard if the fabric is 42 inches wide (quilting cotton, linen, denim etc.)

Lining 1/2 yard (quilting cotton)

SF101 20 inches wide 3/4 yards

Additional Supplies:

Sallie Tomato 1/2 inch Level 3 Basic Hardware Kit **OR**

2 Swivel hooks- 1/2 in size;

2 D-rings- 1/2 inch size;

1 slider 1/2 inch size

#5 zippers- 4 zippers each 12 inches long with single slide or purchase zippers by the yard

Stabilizers for embroidery, either medium weight tear away or sticky back tear away

Embroidery design, customer's choice

Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine with embroidery unit or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring embroidery unit, power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

Required Feet/Hoops/Accessories/Needles (Extra needles are not included with Machine Rental)

Denim needle 90/14 if using denim or canvas

Universal needle 90/14 or 80/12 if using cotton or linen

Straight stitch foot

Zipper foot

Foot for embroidery
Hoop, grid, and clips to fit your design choice

Rotary Cutting Supplies

Cutter and Mat
Rulers

General Sewing Supplies(Not included with Machine Rental)

Straight Pins,
Wonder Clips
Scissors/Snippers
Seam Ripper
Turning Tool
Marking Tools (Water Soluble Fabric Marker, Pencil, Pen, Chalk)
Iron and Pressing Mat (optional – some available on site)
Extra Sewing Machine Needles
Double-sided basting tape or glue stick
Stiletto

Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes
Sack Lunch and Drink

Pre-Work:

The outside of this bag can be made from, quilting cotton, denim, lightweight canvas, linen or pro light cork (traditional cork is too heavy). For the lining, use cotton or linen. If you are a beginner, I would suggest using quilting cottons for your first try.

Cut all the pieces for the entire bag, cutting directions are on page 1 **EXCEPT** do not cut the pieces you want to embroider. You need to cut these pieces larger to fit the hoop for the embroidery. Once the piece or pieces are embroidered then they will be cut to the correct size.

Choose the embroidery design or designs you would like to use. For the bottom panel the design should be no larger than 4 ½ inches high by 6 inches wide.

If you choose to embroider the areas above the zipper stripes, the design should be less than 1 inch high. You may decide to add a name here using your machine fonts or use one of the decorative stitches in your machine.

The store sample is made using light weight denim for the outside and quilting cotton for the lining.

The strawberry design is from OESD.
