### **Fabric Requirements**

30 or more 1 ¼" strips of fabric. These can be scraps, jelly roll strips cut in half, or fat quarters. *Have some strips cut before class and bring extra fabric with you.* 

Scraps of fabric for centers (not cut into strips). These need to be approx. 12" wide (or any size if you want to fussy cut)

The amount of fabric needed depends on the size of the bowl you want. If you want multiple colors, cut at least 2 strips from each fabric before class. This will get you started.

Applique fabric - bring this to class. The size of the fabric design makes a difference in the size of the bottom of the bowl. You can fussy cut before cutting, if you'd like. The sample was made with Pioneer Women's Fabric.

### **Notions/Embellishments**

100 - 300 feet of 3/16th or ¼ inch COTTON CLOTHESLINE (natural color) - NOT ROPE Sharp Scissors
4-6 straight pins (Magic Pins work great!)
Wonder Clips
Glue Stick
Fabric Glue

### **Sewing Machine**

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class). Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine.

Sewing machine must be in working order and must have an adjustable ZigZag Stitch. It must also be capable of stitching through multiple thicknesses.

# Required Feet/Accessories/Needles (Extra needles are not included with Machine Rental)

ZigZag Stitch Presser Foot (BERNINA owners - Foot #34 is excellent for this!) ZigZag Stitch Plate for machine Size 90/14 Topstitch or Denim Needle

### **Specialty Rulers** - NONE

# **Thread** (Thread is not included with Machine Rental)

You can use one color of thread, or you can change your thread color to match each fabric, if desired. Wind 2 bobbins with matching thread. If you are renting a machine, you will wind your bobbins before class.

# Stabilizer, Interfacing, Batting

Iron-on interfacing (for bottom/applique piece). We suggest Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 Double Stick Fusible Web, which is available at Chestnut Ridge. You will need a piece large enough for the bottom of your basket and additional if you plan to make coasters or trivets.

Cutter with sharp blade, Mat, and Ruler

# **General Sewing Supplies** (Not included with Machine Rental)

Straight Pins (Magic Pins work great!)
Wonder Clips
Scissors/Snippers and Seam Ripper
Turning Tool
Marking Tools (Water Soluble Fabric Marker, Pencil, Pen, Chalk)
Iron and Pressing Mat (optional – some available on site)
Extra Sewing Machine Needles

### **Pre-Class Instructions**

Have some of the 1 1/4" strips cut before class and bring your extra fabric with you.

The amount of fabric needed depends on the size of the bowl you want. If you want multiple colors, cut at least 2 strips from each fabric before class. This will get you started.
