Fabric Requirements

Check the material list for sizes; fabric sizes will depend on the size clutch you will be making.

Outside fabric

Lining fabric

Small piece of cork if you choose to use it. See cutting directions.

Notions/Embellishments

#3 nylon zipper 9 -14 inches

Sewing Machine

Bring your sewing machine with embroidery module, cords, etc. or you can rent a machine.

Hoop depends on the size clutch you are making, see instructions below

Embroidery foot

Needles: 75/11 embroidery or Topstitch 80/12

Thread

Embroidery Threads-you choose the colors you like

Bobbin thread

Stabilizer, Interfacing, Batting

Polymesh stabilizer

Soft N Stable by Annie (check your stash, you may have a piece large enough, check the Materials List for the size you are making)

OESD Fuse and Fleece or you can substitute a light weight fusible batting

General Sewing Supplies (Not included with Machine Rental)

Straight Pins

Wonder Clips

Scissors

Snippers

Seam Ripper

Turning Tool

Marking Tools (Water Soluble Fabric Marker, Pencil, Pen, Chalk)

Iron and Pressing Mat (optional – some available on site)

Extra Sewing Machine Needles: 75/11 embroidery or Topstitch 80/12

Hand sewing needle

Tape

Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for making notes

Sack Lunch and Drink

Pre-Class Instructions

Purchase the Garden Flower Clutch by Sookie Sews. Print off the directions.

Download the design size of your choice into your machine or USB. If you are renting one of our Berninas you will need the EXP format. If you are unsure how to do this I will help you in class.

This pattern contains 4 different sizes of clutches. Decide which size you want to do and then cut fabrics according to instructions. I have included a list for hoop sizes and corresponding bag sizes below.

Small – Hoop with a 5 in. x 7 in. hoop stitching field- (Bernina large oval) Bag size-5.01 in. x 7.09 in

Medium – Hoop with a 5 in. x 7 in. hoop stitching field (Bernina large oval) Bag size-5.25 in. x 9.69 in.)

Large – Hoop with a 6 in. by 10 in. stitching field (BERNINA Midi hoop) Bag size-6.21 in. x 9.98 in.

Extra Large – Hoop with an 8 in. x 12 in. stitching field (BERNINA Maxi hoop) Bag size- 7.81in. X 11.80in.

For the top of the bag, area above the zipper, the pattern requires cork. On one bag I chose to use fabric instead. If you chose to use fabric instead of cork, please bring extra fabric.

You can use cork for the “Outside Back” piece if you want in place of fabric. In addition to the cork cut a piece of Soft & Stable. This will help to keep the cork flat and smooth.

We should have enough time to make a second clutch, come prepared if you would like to do an extra one.
