

# **Class Supply List**

Class: Mondo Bag with a TWIST!

Dates: Tuesday, November 14, 2023

**Time:** 9:30am – 4:00pm (Doors open 9:00)

**Instructor:** Elisa Milano

Pattern: Quiltsmart Mondo Bag – Pattern AND interfacing to complete one Mondo Bag.

#### **Fabric Requirements**

**The bag requires 208 – 2 ½ inch squares** which can be gotten from Jelly Rolls strips, yardage, scraps, or a charm pack.

- 15 2½ inch X 40 strips of fabric (12 strips will be used for the bag, 2 strips will be used for handles and 1 strip will be used to hold the D Ring and Swivel hook.) **OR**
- 52-5 inch squares instead of 2 ½ inch squares (you can cut up into squares). Will also need 3-2 ½ inch strips WOF for handles and holders **OR**
- $208 2 \frac{1}{2}$  inch squares you can use all the little squares from your stash and give your bag a scrappy look. Will also need  $3 2 \frac{1}{2}$  inch strips WOF for handles and holders that coordinate.

Bag and Handle Lining and Pockets -1 % yards of fabric that coordinates with your squares. You can also construct handles from 2.5" squares if you like. You will need  $\sim$  50 squares depending on how long you would like your handles.

**Fusible Fleece or Soft and Stable**— 1 ¼ yards, if width is at least 40 inch wide, if less, you will need to be able to cut 4 pieces approximately 9" x 40" and 2 pieces 2 ½" X 26". I prefer Soft and Stable; it gives the bag more structure. If using Soft and Stable, you will also need basting spray. I really like 505 as it does not gum up my machine or needle.

## **Supply List**

- Mondo Bag Pattern AND Interfacing Available at sign-up
- Walking Foot is VERY helpful, but optional
- Sewing machine including power cord, foot pedal and bobbin
- Extra Sewing machine needles
- Thread for piecing bag and quilting lining and batting. Thread should blend with lining.
- Thread for topstitching bag I like buttonhole or embroidery thread. Please bring 90/14 sewing needle if using buttonhole thread. Pick color that will coordinate with you bag fabric.
- Pins, scissors, seam ripper
- Pen, pencil, and paper
- Rotary Cutting supplies (cutter, mat and rulers)
- Zipper to match 1 or 2 depending on number of pockets desired. 9-inch-long or longer per zipper
- Swivel hook and D ring set − ½ to 1 inch will work
- Fast Turn tool for handles or any tool you use to turn tubes to right side.
- Encourage you to bring an iron and pressing mat. This will save you time in the construction process.

505 basting spray if using Soft and Stable or NON-fusible batting.

#### **Sewing Machine**

This will be a hands-on class and a sewing machine is required. Participants MUST understand how to sew and be familiar with sewing machine operation.
