

Class Supply List

Be sure to purchase your supplies ahead of class so that you are prepared! All students receive a 15% discount on supplies required for classes. Please bring your Supply List as your coupon for a 15% discount.

Fabric Requirements - based on 48" x 58" quilt - Please email me for additional size options

Foundation Fabric (Consistent Fabric – light green in sample) – 2 yards

Prints – you will need a variety of scraps that measure at least 1 ½" x at least 6 ½" (6/block, which means 480 total)

In terms of yardage, that means you will need approx. 3 ½ yards total **SEE NOTE BELOW**

Border $1 - \frac{1}{3}$ yard Border 2 - 1 yard

Binding – ½ yard (if you choose to use scraps for the binding, you will need 230")

Backing – 3 yards

Pre-Class Work

Coming to class with your 5 ½" foundation squares cut (80 are needed for the sample size quilt) and at least some 1 ½" x 6 ½" scraps (Do NOT cut all of them) will mean you can jump right into the construction of the blocks. **You can cut scraps into strips that measure 1 ½" x whatever length, as long as they are 6 ½" and bring those to class. Doing this will allow you to have a little more freedom when choosing which strips to use during the block construction.**

Sewing Machine

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Required Feet/Accessories/Needles (Extra needles are not included with Machine Rental)

1/4" foot is suggested for piecing

Thread (Not included with Machine Rental)

Any neutral thread color (cream, beige, tan, gray, etc.)

Rotary Cutting Supplies

Rotary Cutter with sharp blade

Cutting Mat - rotating mat is helpful, and one that is at least 12" x 18"

Rulers - small ruler at least 6" square (trimming) and one that is at least 12" (cutting yardage)

General Sewing Supplies (Not included with Machine Rental)

Pins and/or seam align glue Scissors/Snippers and Seam Ripper Marking Tools (pencils, pens, marker, or chalk) Iron and Pressing Mat (optional – some available on site) Extra Sewing Machine Needles

Misc. Items

Pen, pencil and paper for taking notes Sack Lunch and Drink (with lid please), if desired
