Nancy's instructions are easy to understand and fun to sew!
Photos are included in each step. Materials list:

Fabric

- ½ yd - Fabric 1 - Bag front/back lower pocket, inside pockets
- ¾ yd - Fabric 2 - Outside pocket accent/lining, inside lining
- ½ yd - Fabric 3 - Bag top edge front/ back, inside pocket accent
- ½ yd - Fabric 4 - Straps, bottom, top zipper flap

Interfacing

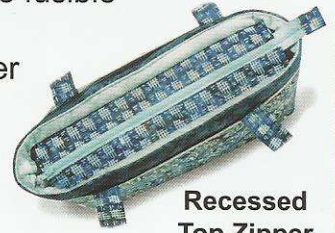
- 1 yd - Pellon #987F Fusible Fleece™
- ¾ yd - Pellon #809 Decor Bond™ fusible
- ⅛ yd - Pellon #71F Peltex™ single side fusible

Notions

- 1 - 14" long all purpose polyester zipper
- Jeans/Denim (90/14) machine needle

Optional

- 1 - Zipper pull or ¼ yard ¾" ribbon

In addition you will need

- 1 set of 4 Edgwenia strap holders*

- 1 set of purse feet

Extra fabric pieces if you want to add pockets for cell phone and keys (4 pieces approx. 6X8 inches)

- Bring ¼ yd Peltex instead of ⅛th as listed in pattern*

- * These items are in stock at the shop.

SEWING ACCESSORIES

- Sewing Machine

- Walking Foot

- Patchwork Foot with guide or Edge Foot

- Needles: Topstitch #90/14 or Metallic, Twin needle 130/705 H ZWI, 4/80

- Empty bobbin

- Wonder Clips

- Straight Pins

- Scissors, seam ripper, etc.

- Rotary Cutter and Mat

- Chalk or Fabric Pencil

- Iron and Mat optional (some are available on-site)

- Superior Metallic Thread

- Don't forget your lunch!**
