Fabric

1/2 yd - Fabric 1 - Bag front/back lower pocket, inside pockets

3/4 yd - Fabric 2 - Outside pocket accent/lining, inside lining

1/2 yd - Fabric 3 - Bag top edge front/ back, inside pocket accent

½ yd - Fabric 4 - Straps, bottom, top zipper flap

Interfacing

1 yd - Pellon #987F Fusible Fleece™

3/4 vd - Pellon #809 Decor Bond™ fusible

1/8 yd - Pellon #71F Peltex™ single side fusible

Notions

1 - 14" long all purpose polyester zipper Jeans/Denim (90/14) machine needle

Optional

1 - Zipper pull or 1/4 yard 3/8" ribbon



Top Zipper

In addition you will need

1 set of 4 Edgwena strap holders*

1 set of purse feet

Extra fabric pieces if you want to add pockets for cell phone and keys (4 pieces approx. 6X8 inches)

Bring 1/4 yd Peltex instead of 1/8th as listed in pattern*

Sewing Machine

Walking Foot

Patchwork Foot with guide or Edge Foot

Needles: Topstitch #90/14 or Metallic, Twin needle 130/705 H ZWI, 4/80

Empty bobbin

Wonder Clips

Straight Pins

Scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Rotary Cutter and Mat

Chalk or Fabric Pencil

Iron and Mat optional (some are available on-site)

Superior Metallic Thread
