



Dresden Appliqué Trivet Instructions



Preparation:

- Read entire instructions before beginning.
- Gather supplies and threads. (See Supply List)

Instructions:

Step 1	Step 2	Step 3	Step 4
<p>Cut 1 layer of OESD HeavyWeight Tear Away, and one layer of light fabric large enough to hoop.</p>	<p>Adhere layers together with temporary adhesive spray. Hoop both layers as one.</p>	<p>Stitch Design 12582-07, following the thread chart, changing colors as desired to coordinate with fabric. Follow appliqué instructions for your favorite technique. Stitch all but the last color change.</p>	<p>Before stitching the last color change, change the bobbin thread to a dark or black color (to contrast with stabilizer). Stitch the seam stitch with a color in the needle that matches the fabric.</p>
			
Step 5	Step 6	Step 7	Step 8
<p>Remove the project from the hoop. Do not remove stabilizer. Flip the project to the back and trim the block to ¼" away from the black bobbin seam line.</p>	<p>Using the same steps, stitch and trim 3 tiles of 12582-07, until you have 4 matching tiles completed and trimmed. Try out different appliqué techniques on each square.</p>	<p>Place two blocks together, right side together. Use Wonder clips to hold pieces together. Stitch with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams open.</p>	<p>Using the same steps, stitch the remaining two blocks together.</p>
			

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Step 9	Step 10	Step 11	Step 12
<p>Stitch all blocks together with a 1/4" seam, matching the edges of the wedges together to form a plate.</p>	<p>Layer the quilt back, Insul-Bright (shiny sides up), and top.</p>	<p>Adhere all layers with temporary adhesive spray. Center the top (right side facing up) as it will slightly smaller than the Insul-Bright (shiny sides up) and the backing (right side facing down).</p>	<p>Stitch in the ditch through all layers using a slightly longer stitch length.</p>
			
Step 13	Step 14	Step 15	Step 16
<p>When quilting is finished, trim all layers even.</p>	<p>Zig Zag around the completed trivet edges.</p>	<p>Bind using your favorite method. Your Dresden Plate trivet is complete.</p>	<p>Enjoy!</p>
