






Step by Step Instructions



Preparation:

- Read through entire instructions before beginning.
- Gather supplies and threads. (See Supply List)
- Write thread numbers below and throughout instructions.
 - Thread A: Matches large appliqué fabric _____
 - Thread B: Matches small appliqué fabric _____
 - Thread C: Details on large appliqué (may be same as Thread B) _____













Instructions:

| Step 1 | Step 2 | Step 3 | Step 4 |
|--|---|---|--|
| Hoop two layers of OESD Aqua Mesh stabilizer. | Stitch Color Change 1: Appliqué placement stitch. Use the Thread A _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. | Cut a piece of appliqué fabric 4" by 6" and a piece of Stabil Stick Tear Away 4" by 6". | Peel the release paper from the Stabil Stick. |

| Step 5 | Step 6 | Step 7 | Step 8 |
| Place the adhesive side of the Stabil Stick onto the wrong side of the appliqué fabric | Lightly spray the back of the stabilizer (now applied to the back of the appliqué fabric) with temporary adhesive spray. | Place the appliqué fabric right side up onto the placement line stitched on the Aqua Mesh stabilizer. | Stitch Color Change 2: Cut line. Use Thread A _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. |

| Step 9 | Step 10 | Step 11 | Step 12 |
|---|--|--|--|
| Using a pair of in the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. | Note that the cut line is a double line of stitching. The second line will secure the fabric, so it is safe to cut very close to the outermost line. | Stitch Color Change 4: Appliqué placement stitch. Use the Thread A _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. | Prepare the other 4" by 6" fabric with Stabil Stick as before. Lightly spray with temporary adhesive spray and place fabric over placement stitch. |

| Stitch Color Change 5: Cut line. Use Thread A _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. | Using a pair of in the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. | Stitch Color Change 6: Appliqué placement stitch. Use Thread B _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. | Prepare one 2 1/2" by 3 1/2" appliqué fabric with Stabil Stick as with the large appliqué pieces. |

| Step 17 | Step 18 | Step 19 | Step 20 |
| Lightly spray the back of the appliqué and Stabil Stick and place over the placement stitch. | Stitch Color Change 7: Cut line. Use Thread B _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread. | Using a pair of in the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line. | Stitch Color Change 8: Appliqué placement line. Use Thread B _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin. |

| <p>Prepare the last 2 ½" by 3 ½" appliqué fabric with Stabil Stick as before. Lightly spray the back of the appliqué fabric with temporary adhesive spray and place over the placement stitch.</p> | <p>Stitch Color Change 9: Cut line. Use Thread B _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin.</p> | <p>Using a pair of in the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line.</p> | <p>Stitch Color Change 10: Large appliqué details. Use Thread C _____ in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin.</p> |

| <p>Wind a bobbin with Thread B _____.</p> | <p>Stitch Color Change 11: eyelets. Use Thread B _____ in both the needle and the bobbin.</p> | <p>Wind a bobbin with Thread A _____.</p> | <p>Stitch Color Change 12: Outer appliqué cover stitch. Use Thread A _____ in both the needle and the bobbin.</p> |

| Step 29 | Step 30 | Step 31 | Step 32 |
| <p>Stitch Color Change 13: small appliqué cover stitch. Use Thread B _____ in both the needle and the bobbin.</p> | <p>Remove the project from the hoop and cut away most of the Aqua Mesh stabilizer.</p> | <p>Rinse away the remaining Aqua Mesh stabilizer. Allow the project to air dry on a flat surface overnight or press dry.</p> | <p>Use a pair of sharp scissors or an eyelet punch to open the embroidered eyelets on the project.</p> |

| Step 33 | Step 34 | Step 35 | Step 36 |
|--|---|--|--|
| <p>Fill your goody bag first before attaching the topper. Fold down the top of the bag the desired amount.</p> | <p>Place the folded Goody Bag topper over the bag so the hinge rests on the fold you just created in the bag.</p> | <p>Thread your ribbon into your tapestry needle.</p> | <p>Starting from the front, thread the ribbon from one of the front eyelets through to the coordinating eyelet on the back piece, piercing the bag with the needle in the process.</p> |

| Step 37 | Step 38 | | |
| <p>Thread the ribbon from the opposite eyelet on the backside through to the coordinating eyelet on the front side, piercing the bag in the process.</p> | <p>Unthread the ribbon from the needle, and tie the loose ends of the ribbon together in a bow.</p> | | |
