Using a pair of in the hoop appliqué scissors, trim as close as possible to the cut line.	Note that the cut line is a double line of stitching. The second line will secure the fabric, so it is safe to cut very close to the outermost line.	Stitch Color Change 4: Appliqué placement stitch. Use the Thread A in the needle and OESD bobbin thread in the bobbin.	Prepare the other 4" by 6" fabric with Stabil Stick as before. Lightly spray with temporary adhesive spray and place fabric over placement stitch.
