### **Fabric Requirements:**

One fat eighth yard white for background 1/8 yard gray for checkered borders and binding 8" x 14" strip of cotton backing fabric 3" x 6" of 5 assorted colors (fabrics) 3" x 6" red (tomato pincushion) 3" x 6" green (tomato pincushion) 7 x 13" of Warm & Natural Needled Cotton batting

### **Additional Supplies:**

Bring or rent a sewing machine with embroidery module, presser foot, cord etc. Embroidery hoop with 8 inches by 12 inches embroidery field (Bernina Maxi) with grid Bobbins

Machine feet: embroidery foot, quarter inch foot Stabilizer (medium tear away) for hooping Embroidery thread to match all fabrics Bobbin thread

Fusible web such as Steam-A-Seam Lite 2, OESD Fuse & Fix or your favorite

## **General Supplies:**

USB Stick with designs
Printed Instructions
Straight Pins
Wonder Clips
Scissors/Snippers
Seam Ripper
Appliqué Scissors
Water Soluble Fabric Marker
Tape
Tweezers

Extra Embroidery Needles 80/12 or 90/14 A small light box is helpful but optional

### **Pre- class Work:**

Purchase and download the embroidery design for the satin stitch option to your machine or USB. (This project gives you a blanket stitch in the hoop option, a decorative stitch option, and a hand embroidery option. I will talk about these in class.)

Print the directions and bring with you to class

Cut background fabric, border strips, and binding strips. Label pieces please.

Pick out your fabric scraps for the tomato pin cushion, tape measure, and the stack of fabrics. We will fuse and cut these out in class.
