#### **FABRIC LIST**

Fabric A 1 yard (The tan fabric)

Fabric B 1 yard (The black fabric)

Fabric C 3/4 yard (The red fabric)

Fusible light-weight batting 1/2 yard (44 inches wide)

Fusible foam 1/2 yard (58 inches wide) such as Soft and

Stable

Peltex 1/3 yard for bottom of bag.

22-24 inch separating zipper

4 Purse feet for the bottom of the bag

"Homemade" Oval and zipper pull

## **SEWING ACCESSORIES**

Thread to match all fabrics **Sewing Machine** Regular foot for straight stitches Foot for zigzag stitches Walking Foot Wonder Clips Long Straight Pins Scissors, seam ripper, etc.

Rotary Cutter and Mat (some are available on-site)

Chalk or Fabric Pencil

Iron and Pressing Mat optional (some are available on-site)

# **CLASS PREP WORK**

Allow 4-6 hours for this prep work

Follow the pattern instructions for

- 1) Cutting and labeling The pattern has a sheet of labels that are color-coded and tell you the name of the piece, the size to cut and how many of each piece to cut.
- 2) Fusing Follow step 1-7 on page 7
- 3) Quilting There is a list in the pattern of the pieces to be quilted. (Page 8, Step 8)
- 4) Handles Sew according to instructions (Page 8, Step 9)
