The outside of this bag can be made from, quilting cotton, denim, lightweight canvas, linen or pro light cork (traditional cork is too heavy). For the lining, use cotton or linen. Check back of pattern for fabric requirements and supplies.

### **Notions/Embellishments/Hardware**

2 Swivel hooks- ½ in size

2 D-rings- ½ inch size

1 slider ½ inch size

#5 zippers- 4 zippers each 12 inches long with single slide or purchase zippers by the yard

“Handmade” hardware optional

SF 101 or equivalent

### **Sewing Machine**

Bring your own machine or rent one from the shop (reserve when registering for the class).

Bring power cord, foot pedal, and manual (you never know!), if using your own machine

### **Required Feet/Hoops/Accessories/Needles (Extra needles are not included with Machine Rental)**

If using pro cork, a microtex needle works best, either a 90/14 or 80/12

If using denim or canvas, use a denim needle 90/14

If using cotton or linen, use a universal needle 90/14 or 80/12

Straight stitch foot

Zipper foot

Cutter and Mat

Rulers

Straight Pins,

Wonder Clips

Scissors/Snippers and Seam Ripper

Turning Tool

Extra Sewing Machine Needles  
Double-sided basting tape or glue stick  
Paper tape  
Stiletto
